EPA certifies and licenses asbestos-removal contractors, inspects asbestos-abatement projects, and enforces laws regarding the proper removal and disposal of asbestos-containing materials.

Currently, EPA and DEQ contract with Industrial Hygiene Resources in Garden City, Idaho, to regulate asbestos removal and disposal projects in Idaho.

Demolition Permit Checklist

All items on this checklist must be presented before any permit application will be accepted.

The following items are needed to apply for a demolition permit:

- Recorded Warranty Deed (a copy may be obtained from the Clerk's Office in the Courthouse)
- Written Statement from Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) that the structure being demolished is asbestos free or what steps must be taken for asbestos abatement.
- Site plan showing setbacks, well, septic, property lines, driveway, power lines, etc.
